Irene was appointed as a non-executive director to the Epta board in July 2026.

From 2020 until 2026, she was a Senior Manager and led the Growth Capability practice at Founders Intelligence, bringing start-up thinking to corporates looking to build new businesses and launch innovative propositions. She built and led innovation teams for large multinationals in energy, mobility, consumer goods, legal, technology and banking. Her work included defining commercial and growth strategy at CEO and Board level, driving execution by building and scaling innovation teams, and establishing start-up partnerships. She also helped large corporates test and launch new businesses, including a low carbon trading platform for a large energy player, AI enabled governance for a law firm, and digital identity offering for a major bank.

Prior to Founders Intelligence, Irene spent five years building and launching digital products at IDEO. She was also in the M&A team at Bain & Co Milan, and helped a tech startup for family businesses scale across South America.
